YEAR 11 GCSE RESULTS DAY: THURSDAY 23rd AUGUST 2018

GCSE Results for Year 11 will be issued between 9.30 am - 11.00 am on Thursday 23rd August 2018 from E Block. If you arrive after 11.00 am, you will need to collect your results from the Exams Office (A22). If you want to pick your results up yourself after Thursday, please see Mr Hunter or Mr Jeffreys in the Exams Office.

If you are unable to collect your results in person, please complete the Request for Results form (available from the exams office or the school website). This gives several alternative ways to obtain your results if you cannot collect them yourself. We will only release these results to the individual named on the form, who will need to produce valid identification in order to collect the results. The form must be received by Mr. Jeffreys before the end of the Summer Term (Friday 20th July).

NB: We cannot issue results over the phone, or to anyone not authorised by the student in writing to collect them.

Please note also that the results statements issued on 23rd August are provisional and may change after post-results enquiries (eg review of marks, re-marks, etc). GCSE Results Certificates (i.e. the legal proof of results) are sent to schools at the end of October. Any other certificates already received (eg BTEC, OCR Nationals, GCSEs taken in earlier sessions, etc) will be given out with the provisional GCSE results statement in August.

Sixth Form/Post-16 Enrolment

After collecting their results, students should enroll immediately into Sixth Form if they are intending to start at Finham Park School. They must not leave the school site until they have done so. Sixth form staff will be available until 3.00 pm on Thursday only.

If students have chosen to stay at Finham but have missed the entry criteria for their subject choices, they should not leave the school site as they will have a meeting arranged with a member of senior staff who will be able to discuss alternative courses and other options. Students will be notified of their meeting time which will be scheduled on Thursday morning if that is the case.

NB: Where possible, students should attend sixth form enrolment with their parents to help in the decision making process so that we can help students to make a fully informed decision.

Jo Hooke, Careers Adviser will be in school on Thursday 23rd and Friday 24th August and will be available to offer advice and support for students. These will be
