## Re: Cycling to/from school from September 2021

Finham Park School continues to support students who wish to cycle to school and recognises the benefits of cycling, including; improved mental and physical health, improved student independence and reduced congestion, noise and pollution in the community.

In order to ensure that we have enough bicycle storage space for our ever growing school community and to promote safe cycling, from the 6<sup>th</sup> September 2021 we are going to issue cyclists with a bike permit to ensure we have enough bike storage for them all. We are expanding our bike storage provision over the next 12 months to enable more and more students to access this healthy way of travelling to and from school.
