## **RAP Project Student Talk – 9 February 2023**

Finham Park School has arranged for Allison Harvey from the RAP project to come in and talk to all our students as part of our pastoral development programme on the 9<sup>th</sup> February 2023.

Alison is the CEO of The RAP Foundation (Raising Awareness and Prevention) and will be presenting talks to all students lasting between 45 minutes and 1 hour tailored for individual year groups. These sessions will be interactive and include information on gaming, grooming, social media and the fact that some young people are content producing, curating their life online. The talks will also look at toxic masculinity, rape culture, the importance of empathy and apologising, the pressures boys are dealing with, the legal definitions of sexual offenses and influencers.

Alison will also be providing a handout for the students, with fantastic resources they may find pertinent, as well as follow up resources for mentors.

The draft schedule and topics are highlighted below:

(8.45 – 9.30): Y12 and Y13 - Topic: Everyone's Invited + Big leaps session  
(9.30 – 10.15): Year 11 - Topic: Everyone's Invited: What Now  
(10.15 – 11.15): Year 10 - Topic: Social Skills for Life  
(11.35 – 12.35): Year 9 - Topic: Altered, Airbrushed and Unrealistic + Social Skills combined  
(12.35 – 1.35): Year 8 - Topic: Digital Natives+ Social Skills  
(2.15 – 3.15): Year 7 - Topic: Digital Natives.
